- → Restrooms are located throughout the facility.



EVACUATION PROCEDURES

- \rightarrow Alarm sounds and strobes will flash.
- → Do not panic.

SHELTER IN PLACE

→ Communication and instruction will be provided by your host.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

- → You can obtain safety glasses from bins located at entry points.
- → Hearing protection is provided where required.
- → Steel toed covers are provided where required.

VISITOR SAFETY AND SECURITY GUIDELINE SUMMARY

- → Cellphone and video cameras are not allowed in the manufacturing areas. Please leave them in a conference room or at the front desk.
- → In accordance with ITAR, visitors must be a U.S Citizen or Permanent Resident.
